# TRIP REGISTRATION OPENS ON AUGUST 1!



## REGISTRATION:

All registration and paperwork will be done through an online platform called Managed Missions. You will use the same log in that you created when you filled out the interest form. To sign up for this trip, you will create a profile using the link provided on the right - and pay the \$50 trip deposit - by September 1, 2025. This application will open on August 1!

## PASSPORTS:

A passport is required for everyone participating in this trip and is not included in the trip cost. The current passport fee is \$165 and process time is around 3 months. We suggest applying for a passport when you register for this trip in order to have it in hand by December 1 when we will be purchasing flights. ## VACCINATIONS:

We recommend consulting your health care provider at least 6 weeks before departure to inquire about recommended vaccinations for your trip. King's Castle Ministries recommends all participants have a tetnus shot, along with the shots recommended by public schools. Visit <https://wwwnc.cdc.gov/travel> for more information.



## TRIP COST:

Trip cost includes all training, travel, lodging, transportation, meals in country, travel insurance, and free day activities. Additional costs include travel-day meals, souvenirs, and passport. **All donations and payments are handled on the Managed Missions platform.** You will have a personal page that you can direct friends/family who wish to support your trip to. This will be given to you once you have registered and paid your deposit.



## FUNDRAISING:

There are many different ways to raise the funds for your trip. You can find more information in the Participant Packet you will receive when you register for a trip to help you with this.



## TEAM TRAINING:

We want to make sure that you are set up for success by preparing you both mentally and spiritually for this trip. **We have a training scheduled for both teams on Saturday, January 24.** You are required to be at this training and will leave inspired, informed, and feeling more connected to your teammates before you leave in March. **There will be an additional online meeting for parents/guardians on February 22 (for those going on the March 14 trip) or March 1 (for those going on the March 21 trip).**
